The month-long celebration will feature a series of lectures, workshops, and engaging activities designed to cultivate learners' appreciation of science.

NSCM will commence with its flagship event, the **National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT)** and interactive activities that promote science, technology, and the environment (ST&E) with other major activities which include the **PSYSC Science Olympiad (PSO), Mathematics, Science, at Kapaligiran (MSKA) and I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS)**.

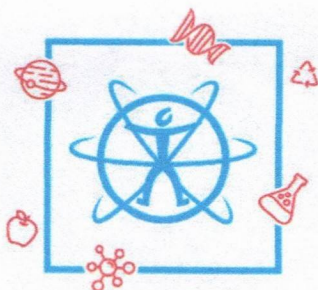

For 55 years, the **Pambansang Kapisanan ng mga Kabataan Samahan ng Agham (Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs), Inc.**, as the first and largest umbrella organization of science clubs in the Philippines, has remained steadfast in delivering high-quality programs and activities to elementary and high school science enthusiasts nationwide. Through these initiatives, the organization advances its core mission of promoting the public understanding of science, technology, and the environment (PUSTE).

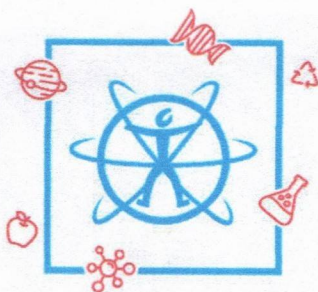
As mandated by the Presidential Proclamation No. 264, s. 2002, PSYSC is honored to join the nation in celebrating **National Science Club Month (NSCM)** this September 2026. The month-long celebration will feature a series of lectures, workshops, and engaging activities designed to cultivate learners' appreciation of science. These events are open to elementary and high school students, as well as teachers, from across the country.

NSCM will commence with its flagship event, the **National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT)**, a one-and-a-half-day gathering featuring lectures, workshops, and interactive activities that promote science, technology, and the environment (ST&E), while fostering camaraderie among elementary, junior high school, and senior high school science club members. Other major activities include the **PSYSC Science Olympiad (PSO)**, a well-established annual nationwide inter-school science quiz competition for elementary and high school students; **Mathematics, Science, at Kapaligiran (MSKA)**, which consists of regional science workshops conducted during the SUMMIT and culminates in a national-level competition in the National Capital Region; and the **I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS)**, which provides science educators with opportunities to exchange effective pedagogical strategies and innovative approaches for delivering engaging lectures and workshops.

To make the spirit and opportunities of NSCM more accessible to science club members across the country, PSYSC has established multiple regional centers to ensure broader participation and inclusivity. The SUMMIT, ITSS, MSKA Interactive and Engineering Science Challenge, and the PSO National Eliminations will be

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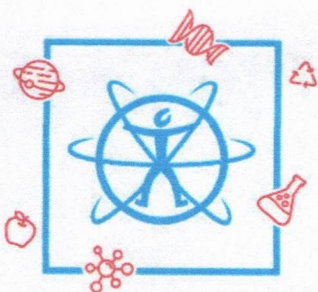
conducted simultaneously on **September 5-6, 2026**, across the following regions: Regions I, II, III, V, VI, IX, XI, and XIII. This simultaneous implementation allows students from diverse parts of the Philippines to experience NSCM within their respective localities.

Additionally, independent sites for the PSO National Eliminations will be held on September 5, 2026, in selected regions to further expand accessibility and participation. The PSO National Finals and MSKA Proper will be conducted simultaneously in the National Capital Region (NCR) on September 26-27, 2025, where top-performing participants from across the country will convene for the culminating competitions.

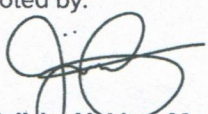

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2026 National Science Club Month (NSCM 2026)

1. The Pambansang Kapisanan ng mga Kabataan Samahan ng Agham (Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs or PSYSC), Inc. announces the celebration of the 2025 National Science Club Month (NSCM) in accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 264, s. 2002 which declares September as the National Science Club Month.
2. PSYSC is a national organization that promotes the public understanding of science, technology, and environment (PUSTE). It supports science and technology education through healthy competitions, lectures, seminars, and interactive workshops for students and teachers alike.
3. The NSCM 2026 celebration aims to:
 - a. Provide a venue for learning science, technology, and the environment outside the four walls of the classroom;
 - b. Foster camaraderie and develop leadership among the Science Clubbers; and
 - c. Encourage active participation of students and teachers during the National Science Club Month and hence, the Science Clubbing Movement.
4. To accomplish its objectives, the following activities will be conducted: **National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT)**, a one-and-a-half-day event featuring lectures, workshops, and interactive activities; **PSYSC Science Olympiad (PSO)**, a nationwide inter-school quiz competition for both elementary and high school students; **Mathematics, Science at Kapaligiran (MSKA)**, which comprises regional workshops during SUMMIT and a culminating national competition; and the **I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS)**, which equips science educators with innovative, engaging pedagogical strategies through lectures and workshops.

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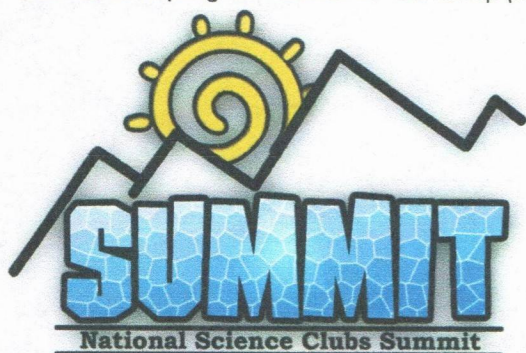

Event Descriptions

National Science Club Month 2025

September is considered the **National Science Club Month (NSCM)** under Presidential Proclamation No. 264. During the NSCM, the **Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC)** conducts activities that encourage the youth to actively participate in the science clubbing movement. Through these activities, PSYSC aims to provide a venue for the interaction of science clubs and to recognize excellence through workshops and friendly competitions. The four (4) main events that will kick-off this year's NSCM are the National Science Clubs Summit (Summit), PSYSC Science Olympiad (PSO), I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS) and Mathematics, Science at Kapaligiran interactive Workshop (MathSciAKa).



The **National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT)** is a one and a half-day gathering of high school science club affiliates, conducted simultaneously in different regions. The event is an opportunity for the different science clubs to learn from lectures, workshops, and plenary sessions. The SUMMIT brings the camp experience closer to our affiliates who are not able to attend the National Youth Science Technology and Environment Summer Camp (NYSTESC). Exciting trademark activities of SUMMIT include Sub-camp Quiz Competition and fun-filled Science workshops. SUMMIT also offers the chance to experience MathSciAKA, an event which provides a set of interactive workshops.

The **Philippine Society of Youth Science Club Science Olympiad (PSO)** is an inter-school quiz competition for elementary and high school students all over the country. This Olympiad consists of two rounds: (1) the National Eliminations, conducted simultaneously in different regions, which will be a written exam that will challenge the students' knowledge on various science categories, and (2) the National Finals, which will be composed of theoretical and practical rounds. Prizes would include cash, plaques, medals and certificates.



The **I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS)** is a two-day activity catering to science teachers of affiliated schools. It is an enrichment seminar packed with lectures, workshops, and discussions for teachers featuring ways on how they can make science teaching fun and interactive. This is PSYSC's way of thanking the teachers for the service they bring to the youth and as well as to the organization.

MathSciAKA is an event composed of many different science workshops known as the Mathematics, Science, At Kapaligiran (MathSciAKa). MathSciAKa has been designed to challenge both the physical and mental capabilities of participating science clubbers. It is usually celebrated on two separate dates – every 1st week of September during the NSCM-SUMMIT which features two sub events: the Engineering Science Challenge and the Interactive Workshop; and every 3rd week of September within the National Capital Region during the MathSciAKa Proper consisting five sub events: Interactive Workshop, On-the-spot Workshop, Take Home, Mystery Workshop and the Workshop Fair.
