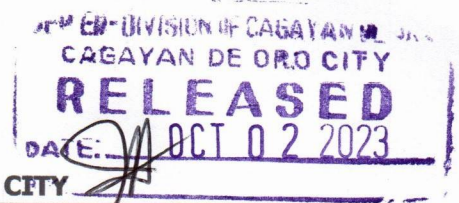

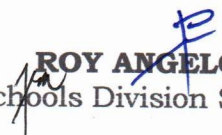

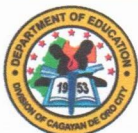
**TRAINING ORIENTATION FOR ONLINE ASSESSMENT IN PREPARATION FOR

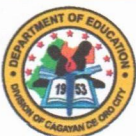

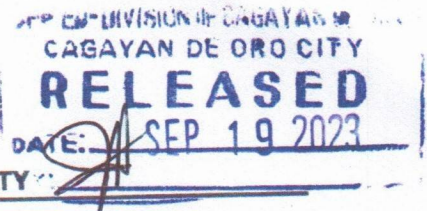

**NEWLY LAUNCHED CURRICULUM PROJECTS UNDER TATAK ROY (RADICAL,
ORIGINAL, YOUTHFUL MINDSET) INITIATIVES**

1. The field is hereby informed about the iCARE (Curriculum Advancement via REsource digitization) program under *Tatak ROY* initiative, which includes five project components that represent our commitment to curriculum innovation, progress, and sustainability in order to better serve our learners and community stakeholders.
2. The iCARE is aligned with the MATATAG agenda, particularly to MAke the curriculum relevant to produce job-ready, active, and responsible citizens; TAke steps to accelerate the delivery of basic education services; TAke good care of learners by promoting learner well-being and inclusiveness learning; and GIve support to teachers to teach better.
3. The five major iCARE initiatives are as follows:
 - (1) **Reading and Arithmetic Enrichment with Gratuity** which aims to improve the math and reading abilities of individuals, usually children, by offering more tools and support for education in a fun and rewarding way. The project seeks to achieve 100% independent readers in the Division of Cagayan de Oro City by the end of the school year 2023-2024;
 - (2) **Rapid Outcome-based & high Yielding assessment** is a dynamic and efficient assessment system designed to swiftly measure learning outcomes and produce significant educational gains using online and offline platforms;
 - (3) **Robotics Outreach for You** aims to foster an interest in robotics and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) among diverse groups of learners, teachers, school leaders, and community stakeholders. By combining hands-on robotics experiences with outreach activities, this project seeks to empower individuals with the knowledge and skills needed to engage with emerging technologies and prepare for future opportunities in STEM fields;
 - (4) **Rhapsody of Youth** is designed to celebrate and nurture the diverse talents of learners during noon breaks in the classroom. This project is rooted in the



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belief that fostering creativity, self-expression, and self-confidence can lead to holistic development and increased enthusiasm for learning; and

(5) Reflective Observation & high Yielding instructional supervision redefine the role of instructional supervisors and transform teaching and learning. It recognizes the need for a more holistic and reflective approach to instructional supervision, one that goes beyond mere observation and evaluation. This project empowers instructional supervisors with effective digital tools, strategies, and a reflective approach to supervision, enabling them to support teachers in their professional growth and contribute to the overall quality of education.

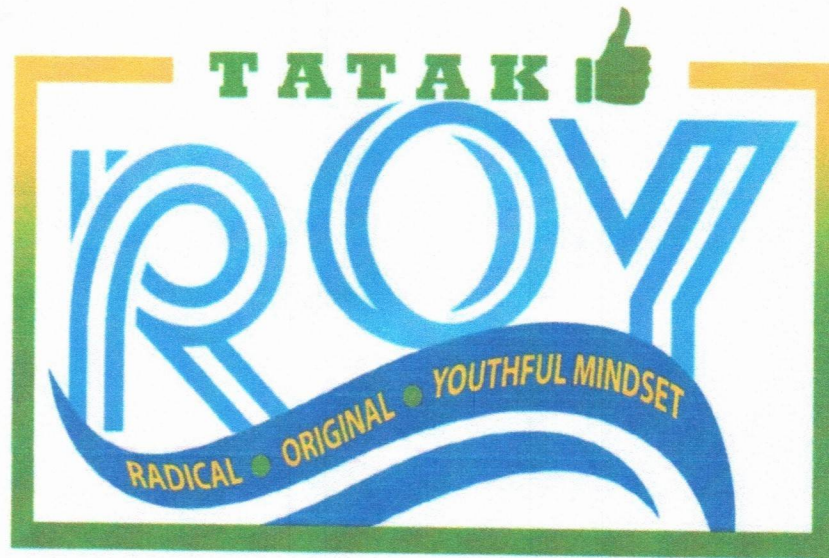
