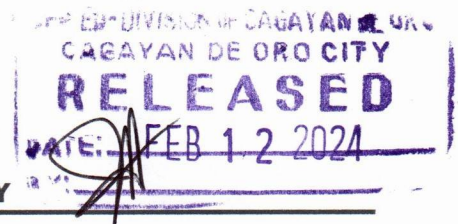

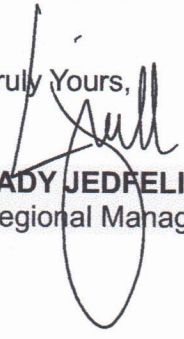
In 2023, the Department of Health - Family Health Cluster, Disease Prevention and Control Bureau with technical support of USAID through RTI International ReachHealth Project collaborated with the Society of Adolescent Medicine of the Philippines, Inc. (SAMPI) updated and revised the Adolescent Job Aid (AJA). The AJA is the key tool of the Adolescent Health Program developed by DOH in cooperation with SAMPI and support of the World Health Organization (WHO) in 2009. AJA has been used to train health service providers nationwide since 2010.

With the revised AJA, the USAID-Reachhealth, DOH and SAMPI conducted the training of trainers in October 2023. These trainers are mandated to roll-out the training. On January 17, 2024, DOH, SAMPI and USAID-Reachhealth agreed to conduct the roll-out Training for Mindanao. The project will be supporting the training for selected DOH CHD, DepEd and LGU program coordinators to be capacitated to facilitate Adolescent Job Aid (AJA) 2.0 Skills Enhancement Training (ASET) in their areas of responsibility. Said Training of Facilitators on ASET for Mindanao is scheduled on **Feb 28, 29 & March 1, 2024, in Cagayan De Oro City**. Venue still to be identified.

In view of this, we would like to request the participation of **Ms. Marie Nikki Jo Valmoria, Nurse II ARH Focal and Rafael Silagan, CSE/ALS Coordinator** for this activity. USAID ReachHealth will shoulder the cost for venue, meals, and training materials. Traveling expenses and allowable per diems is counterpart of sending agency. In addition, as part of the pre-requisite for training, please have the participants complete the Foundational Course on the DOH Academy learning platform and bring her certificate of completion during the training.
