This Division

1. In line with Memorandum DM-CT-2024-246, inviting schools to join the Khan Academy Philippines Inc. (KA PH) program, this office has identified the participating elementary and secondary schools. These schools are required to meet specific conditions to ensure the successful implementation of the program. The requirements are as follows:
 - a. must have stable internet;
 - b. 1:1 device to student ratio in the computer lab;
 - c. commitment to at least 1 Math period of active Khan Academy time per week at school
2. To support proper monitoring and coordination, all identified schools are requested to submit their class schedules for each grade level, clearly indicating the designated Khan Academy period for every section. Schools must provide a report on the readiness of their facilities, specifically detailing the stability of their internet connection and the availability of sufficient devices in their computer labs to their respective Public Schools District Supervisors on or before September 25, 2024.
3. Enclosure 1 indicates the list of participating schools.
4. In adherence to Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) inclusive and fair treatment shall be accorded to all participants regardless of disability, sexual orientation, gender, age, religion, and ethnicity.

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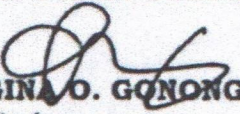
