

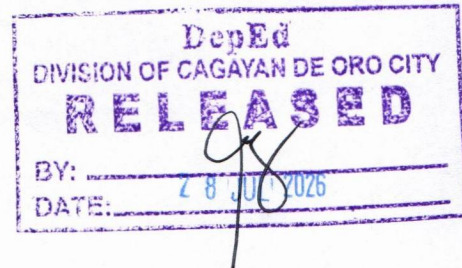

1. In support of the Department of Education's efforts to strengthen disaster preparedness and resilience among learners, this Office announces the conduct of the **Planning and Writeshop for Disaster-Responsive on August 1 & 8, 2026** in a venue to be announced on a separate memorandum.
2. The activity aims to empower learner leaders to become active partners in promoting disaster preparedness, risk reduction, climate resilience, and emergency response initiatives in schools and communities. Through this activity, learner leaders shall formulate programs, projects, and activities that will strengthen school preparedness and foster a culture of safety among learners.

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10121 "*Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010*", and DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2015 "*Comprehensive Disaster Risk Reduction and Management in Basic Education Framework*", schools are enjoined to cultivate a culture of preparedness, resilience, and shared responsibility in safeguarding learners from natural and human-induced hazards. As frontline advocates and catalysts of positive change, learner leaders are empowered to champion disaster risk reduction initiatives, mobilize their peers toward preparedness, and help ensure safe, resilient, and learning-continuous school communities in times of crisis.
